“FSGS: Transplantation”

Patient:       What happens if I have a transplant? Does the disease go away?

Dr. Falk:       In some patients with FSGS, the disease process comes back in the transplanted kidney. This can be seen quite quickly by the sudden development of loss of protein from the transplanted kidney. This is a phenomenon that occurs only in the minority of patients. In the majority of patients with FSGS the disease does not come back and the transplant then continues to work well.
